



Topic: How to factory reset your Apple device?


Before initiating the reset make sure to back up your device and turn off Find My iPhone in settings. All data will be lost if you don't do a backup.*

Steps to do before initiating the factory reset:

1. Go to settings
2. You will see your name or account on the top. Press your name.



3. Press iCloud and scroll down to backup
4. Initiate a backup and wait until it's done
5. After the backup is done go back to the beginning after pressing your name.
6. You will see a section called "Find My" or Find My iPhone"
7. Press Find my iPhone and turn it off. You will have to enter your Apple ID password.



Guide on how to Factory reset your Apple device

1. Open your phone and go to settings
2. Scroll down and press General
3. Scroll down until you see reset
4. You will see multiple types of resets press " Erase all content and setting" to factory reset your device
5. If you have a passcode on your phone it will tell you to enter it
6. It will ask you again to confirm if you want to reset your device. Once you press it, you are good to go, your phone has been fully erased.
